



C/23 EUROPEAN INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP U-17 Small Tables

Art. 1. PARTICIPANTS 16 inscribed sportsmen.

Art. 2. INSCRIPTION and PARTICIPATION of the SPORTSMEN

Each affiliated federation has the right to inscribe more than 3 sportsmen. The sportsmen placed first of the federations are automatically qualified. If the owner of the title takes part, the 2nd sportsman of his federation has the next place. The following sportsman is the 2nd of the organizing federation if this federation doesn't have already a second representative. The remaining places till 16 will be occupied by the 2nd representatives of the federations according the result of the last EC-U17 of the same discipline. If the number 16 is not reached, the 3rd representatives of the federations will enter according the same system.

Art. 3. GAMES OF THE GROUPS – DISTANCE OF THE GAME 25 POINTS – 50 INNINGS – Time Limit

The classification of the inscribed sportsmen will be made according their general averages. **The actual European champion if participating is placed as Number 1.** The 4 groups of 4 sportsmen will then be formed according the system Z. The game will be played with equal innings. If the sportsman doesn't reach the distance of 25 points also in the 50 innings, the opponent will have the inning. The balls are placed on the starting position. A draw is possible. **The 3-Cushion U-17 will be played with a time limit, according to the rules of CEB.** The two first of each group will qualify for the final round. The classification of the eliminated sportsmen will be done according to the criteria listed in the "Basic Concepts of the Sport."

4. FINAL ROUND – DISTANCE OF THE GAME 30 POINTS – 50 INNINGS – Time Limit

The final round will be played in KO system. The eight qualified sportsmen will meet as determined in the following article. The game will be played with equal innings. If the sportsman doesn't reach the distance of 30 points also in the 50 innings, the opponent will have the inning. The balls are placed on the starting position. If the two sportsmen have reached the same number of points also after the 50 innings, it will be, to decide the game, played an extension as described in article 12 of the basic concepts sporting program.

Art. 5. TOURNAMENT SYSTEM

The eight ¼ finalists will be classified following their general average played in the qualification groups from 1 to 8. The first four players of the groups will take the places 1-4, and the second 4 players will take the places 5-8 following their general average

The winners of these games will play the half finals.

The four $\frac{1}{2}$ finalists will be classified from 1-4 following the average played in the $\frac{1}{4}$ final. (By equality, the general average played in the tournament will be considered)
